### 1300 Caller Information

### The Difference between 1800 numbers and 1300 numbers

- The main difference is in the way that the cost of the call divided and paid.
- · The cost of calls to 1800 numbers is paid by the account holder of that number, and is free to the caller
- The cost of calls to a 1300 number or 13 number is shared by both the caller and the 1300 or 1800 number account holder, who pays the remainder.

#### 1300 numbers (often known as Local Call numbers)

- The 1300 number caller: pays the cost of a local call from any fixed line phone anywhere in Australia. Callers using mobile phones pay a rate that is determined by their mobile service provider.
- The 1300 number Account Holder (usually a Business Owner): this varies depending on the telco that carries the 1300 numbers.
- If The Silent Partner carry your 1300 number, when you answer calls to your 1300 number on your fixed landline and the call is from a local fixed landline, your receive 15minutes of FREE talk time on all plans
- After the FREE talk time minutes, call rates apply depending upon where the call has originated from and duration of call.

#### 1800 numbers (also known as Toll Free/Free Call numbers)

- The caller: FREE from any fixed line phone anywhere in Australia. Callers using mobile phones pay a rate that is determined by their mobile service provider.
- Account Holder: Pays the entire cost for the call (there is no free talk time for 1800 numbers).
